Scott was known for his wit, generous spirit, intelligence, leadership at work, and love of good food and drink. Scott is survived by his mother Lucinda and stepfather John N. Gaston III; brother Greg Hill and sister-inlaw Shannon; sister Martha Anne Gaston; and step-siblings Mary Louise Wells (Mitchell), Carrie Ribnikar (Dan), and Bill Gaston (Dee).
