



## Floyd Jay Sargent Jr.

September 14, 1946 - January 8, 2019

Floyd Jay Sargent Jr. (72), passed away on Tuesday, January 8, 2019, in Tallahassee, FL after a long battle with cancer.

He was born in Charlotte, North Carolina on September 14, 1946 to Floyd Jay Sargent Sr. and Frances Rohrer Sargent. The family later moved to Miami, Florida where he graduated from Hialeah High School in 1964. In 1967, Jay enlisted in the Army where he served from 1967 to 1971 and was stationed for a tour in Vietnam where he was awarded a Bronze Star. After he was honorably discharged, he enrolled at Florida International University where he received his Bachelor's degree in Industrial Technology. Jay worked as a Planner on both the municipal level and later on a county level. Once he retired, he purchased a large tract of land in Moultrie, Georgia where he planned to live out his dream of becoming a farmer. For over 10 years, he worked the land into a functional farm that he greatly enjoyed working and living on, and sharing with his family and friends.

Jay is survived by his daughter, Jessica Williams and son in law, Jason Williams, two grandchildren, Evan Williams and Adalynn Williams, his sister, Donna Timmons and his brother, Kenneth Sargent.

He was predeceased by his father Floyd Jay Sargent Sr. and mother Francis Rohrer Sargent.

A private memorial for family and friends will be held on Saturday, January 26, 2019 at 10:00am at Bevis Funeral Home in Tallahassee, FL.
