Joyce later went back to school and graduated as a computer programmer, blazing the trail with other strong women in this field. She enjoyed a long career with the state, where she worked her way up until she retired as a System Project Administrator for the Department of General Services.

Joyce enjoyed playing bridge, was a die-hard Florida State Seminoles fan, and deeply loved spending time with her children, grandchildren, and friends. In fact, she was known for keeping up with all her friends, from her childhood, college & Alpha Gam sorority years, to the friends she made through her husband's military service, in the local community, Junior League, at work and bridge groups.
