



AC Godsey

April 5, 1929 - May 11, 2016

A C Godsey, age 87, native of Double Springs, TN, passed away in his Tallahassee, FL home on May 11, 2016. A C was the grandson of Louis and Roxanne Godsey, son of Altie and Celina.

Raised in the Nashville, TN area, Mr. Godsey entered the Air Force in 1947 at the age of 18. He served for 22 years, including through Korea and Viet Nam, retiring in 1969 with the rank of Master Sergeant. His Air Force career took him and his family to Georgia, Nevada, Okinawa, and California.

In 1971, Mr. Godsey was accepted into the Sky Marshall program, part of U.S. Customs, based in South Florida. He soon transitioned to Customs Inspector and, with 15 years of serving the Federal government, retired in 1985.

During his life A C became a multi-engine private pilot, 33rd Degree Mason (1967), and was an avid golfer until late in life.

A C is survived by his wife of 64 years, Betty Gene (Parr) Godsey; son, Gene Jor-El (Karen) Godsey; daughter, A Crystal Godsey; grandchildren, Jared Kal-El Godsey, Kara Joy Godsey and Joel Kent Godsey.

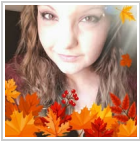
