Allen Lee Freeland, 75, of Tallahassee departed this life unexpectedly on September 2, 2022.

Allen was born June 7, 1947, in Urbana, Illinois, to Warren Allen Freeland and Dorothy Ruth (Taylor) Freeland, both preceding him in death.

Following his graduation from Eastern Illinois University in 1969, he moved to Tallahassee to continue his career with Olin Corporation, now known as St. Marks Powder, General Dynamics (GD) Ordnance and Tactical Systems (OTS).
