Anastasia Patronis Koikos passed away peacefully on June 9, 2024, surrounded by her loving family. She was preceded in death by her husband Jimmy N. Anastasia was a lifelong member of the Holy Mother of God Greek Orthodox Church. She was also one of the founding members of what was once called the Greek Bazaar which is now known as the Greek Food Festival. She graciously volunteered her time and talents until her health problems

She continued to cook all her favorite Greek recipes including her famous baklava until she was unable to do so. One of the highlights in her later years was reconnecting with some of her fellow Leon High School classmates for monthly luncheons.
