Ann Veronica Panzarino, 77, passed away on March 28th, 2022. She is survived by her husband Frank and their four children, Frank Jr. (Brandi), Anissa (Brie), Christopher (Cyndi), and Michael (MacKenzie). In addition to her children, she is survived by her grandchildren— Kaitlyn, Cheyenne, Cody, Michael, Jarrett, Tyler, and Tres.

Ann was a graduate of Albertus Magnus High School and went on to complete degrees at Rockland Community College and St. Vincent's. After earning her nursing degree, she had a long and successful career as a Registered Nurse specializing in Elder Care, Psychiatric Care, and administration as Director of Nursing.

On June 18th, 1966, Frank and Ann were married and started their life together. Over the course of their journey through life they lived in many cities and states including New York, Ohio, Georgia, and finally rooting in Florida.
