Ann Hopkins Wainwright passed away peacefully at home on July 24, 2024, at the age of 80. A native of Leon County, she had a distinguished career with the State of Florida spanning more than three decades, notably ending her career as Assistant Commissioner of Agriculture and Chief of Staff for the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
