Anna Elizabeth "Beth" Hackney, 81, died peacefully Thursday, February 12, 2015 in Tallahassee, FL. Beth was born in Putnam, TX on February 1, 1934, the only daughter of Wade and Imogene Andrews. After graduating from Texarkana, AR High School, she attended St. Edwards School of Nursing in Fort Smith, AR. In 1953, she married James Hackney of Naples, TX. Together they raised four Christian daughters and, by example, taught them to be strong, loving and compassionate.

Beth was a successful career woman, having served in the medical community in Texas and Florida after the family relocated in 1969. She retired from Radiology Associates of Tallahassee in 1999.
