



## Anne Eidemiller Rudloe

December 24, 1947 - April 27, 2012

Anne E. Rudloe, Ph. D., 64, died peacefully at her home in Panacea on Friday, April 27, 2012. A noted marine biologist and author, Anne was managing director (ret.) of Gulf Specimen Marine Lab and Aquarium in Panacea. Her scientific writings include *Priceless Florida: Natural Ecosystems and Native Species*. (with E. Whitney, Ph.D. and B. Means, Ph.D.). She was a dharma master (teacher) in the Kwan Um School of Zen and wrote movingly about her observations and experiences in *Butterflies on a Sea Wind: Beginning Zen, Zen in a Wild Country* and her blog.

She is survived by her husband Jack and sons Sky (Alyssa) and Cypress, both of Tallahassee.
