



## Annette Hickman McIntosh

November 27, 1941 - July 26, 2024

Annette Hickman McIntosh passed away July 26, 2024. She was born on November 27, 1941, to the late Vertice J. and Ollie Ruth Hickman. She graduated from George C. Wallace Technical College where she studied Accounting and Finance in 1960.

In 1962 Annette married her late husband Charles McIntosh and had 2 children: Tony McIntosh and Angie McIntosh Tutton. Annette attended Antioch Baptist Church for over four decades until she started attending Bible Believers Church in Tallahassee. She became a member of the Tallahassee Moose Lodge in 2004. Annette received her Academy of Friendship in 2007, served as Senior Regent in 2013, and received the most prestigious person honor, The College of Regents Degree in 2014. She retired after 34 years of service with the State of Florida, where her most meaningful accomplishment was serving on the implementation team for the Florida Purchasing Card Program.

Annette was preceded in death by her husband of 29 years, Charles McIntosh, her parents Vertice J., and Ollie Ruth Hickman, and two sisters Rachel Motley and Margie Wood. She is survived by her son Tony McIntosh and wife Cindy of Tallahassee, and daughter Angie Tutton and husband Dewayne of Havana. “ It was at Antioch Baptist Church where the Lord introduced me to Sister Annette. To steal a line from the 1942 film *Casablanca*, this would be the beginning of a beautiful friendship that would last for three decades.

*My mentor, the late Brother Allen Brabham, suggested my name to the church as a pastoral candidate back in 1995. Although still wet behind the ears, the church took a chance on me and asked me to become their bi-vocational pastor. On March 19, 1995, I was ordained to the work of Gospel Ministry at Antioch Baptist church; a joyous day I will long remember. Annette along with Bernice McIntyre and the late Lois King, Margaret Harris, and Brother Allen took on the challenge of molding me to be a shepherd of God's people.*

*Annette was thoughtful, loving, and giving. I still have a wooden name plate in my computer room she gave me and my wife has one of her beautiful porcelain dolls. Annette truly cared for me, laughed at my corny jokes, and did everything within her power to help me succeed in ministry. She was a tireless servant of the Lord. She handled church finances as our Treasurer, spent early mornings before Sunday services printing and copying church bulletins, served as Sunday School Director, and on occasion a substitute teacher; she even worked in the nursery when needed which is one of the hardest positions in the church to fill. She was instrumental in many of the church dinners, fish fries with the help of her son Tony, and Homecoming Services. She was one of the pillars of the church and played a vital role in holding things together in good and difficult times in the church's history.*

*After my service at Antioch, we stayed connected. I was invited to return to Antioch to supply preach and served them an additional two years as interim pastor. On each occasion, Annette was there to encourage me. The Lord granted me many blessed hospital visits to see Annette and special times of prayer with her and her family. I cannot think of any funerals of church members where Annette was*

*not present. Even in later years, when it was difficult for her to get around, she would be there at the graveside. Annette will always be remembered by me as a faithful friend, a beloved sister in Christ, and one who used her many gifts to share the love of Jesus Christ with others.*
