Annie Lee Thompson Tubbs, born on March 10, 1924 in Argo, Alabama to Albert and Annie Thompson, the only daughter in a family of 11 children. Her father was a farmer and a Southern Baptist circuit preacher in Alabama. Mrs. Tubbs married her childhood sweetheart Lecil Tubbs in 1942. While Mr. Tubbs was serving overseas in WWII, Mrs. Tubbs worked as a secretary at the local military base. Following the war, Mr. and Mrs. Tubbs moved to New Mexico and raised their five children until moving to Tallahassee in 1956. Mrs. Tubbs worked in the retail business and state government as a bookkeeper. Upon retirement, Mrs. Tubbs moved to Crawfordville where she worked part time for the Wakulla County Sheriff's Office, volunteered with the Wakulla County Senior Citizens, served as church pianist for several local churches and enjoyed working in her garden, quilting and traveling with her husband.

Survivors are Sherry Colvin (Jerome) of Crawfordville; Eddie Tubbs (Mary) of Jacksonville; Marvin Tubbs (Debbie) of Tallahassee; Billie Kaye Matthews (Bob) of Daytona Beach; 12 grandchildren and 26 great grandchildren. She was predeceased by her husband Lecil and son, Ryan. Annie Lee was a beautiful, outgoing person with a warm heart and smile for everyone.
