Arthur Coleman Gay, 86, beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother and uncle passed away at home on Monday, February 5th surrounded by his friends and family. He was born in Geneva, Alabama on August 3, 1931.

After high school, Arthur joined the Army and rose to Master Sergeant and served in Korea with the United States National Guard. After the Army, he volunteered for the Red Cross and pursued a career in radio at WOOF and television at WTVY while living in Dothan, Alabama. A job offer from WCTV brought Arthur and his family to Tallahassee. He then pursued a very successful career in commercial real estate and tax-deferred real estate exchanges, from which he retired in 2015.
