Arthur Giles Kennerly, Jr., 85, a 78-year resident of Tallahassee, died on Wednesday, July 12, 2017. A graveside service at Roselawn Cemetery, 843 Piedmont Drive, will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, July 14, 2017.

Survivors include his wife, Brooke Schnebly Kennerly, his son, A. Giles Kennerly, III, his daughter, Shelby Kennerly Augustyniak (Dan), and his granddaughters, Ella B. Augustyniak and Audrey E. Augustyniak, all of Tallahassee.

A graduate of Leon High School in 1950 and of Florida State University in 1954, his first job after college was at the Tallahassee Democrat where he was a general news reporter and feature writer. Later he was the first public relations director for The Florida Bar, the first full-time employee for the Academy of Florida Trial Lawyers, a lobbyist for the Florida Association of Realtors, a public relations employee for two Florida state government departments, and a history instructor at Tallahassee Community College.

He was an Eagle Scout, a member of St. John's Episcopal Church, a member of several local social organizations, and a member of a college fraternity, the Kappa Alpha Order. Spare time interests included all types of history and all aspects of published literature.
