Barbara will be remembered as the life of the party with her holiday outfits that included a tutu and flashing lights. She touched many lives and will be remembered by all that knew her.

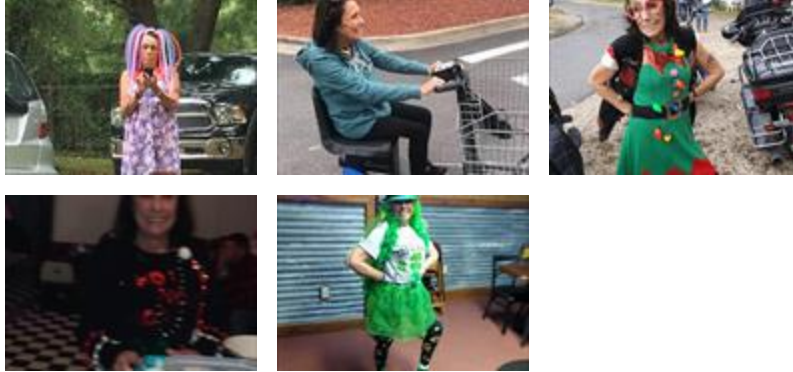
