Betty Moore Durr, age 96, passed away on the morning of Monday, September 5, 2022. Born in Macon, Georgia on December 17, 1925, Betty was the daughter of Oakley Lawrence Moore and Eva Teate Moore. She spent her childhood in Thomasville, Georgia, before returning to Macon as a teenager.

She enjoyed a wonderful marriage of 73 years to her husband, Ralph Munnerlyn Durr, III, who passed in 2019. Betty is survived by her two children, Ralph M. Durr IV (Susan) of Macon, Georgia, and Carol "Tuddie" Walker (Doug) of Tallahassee; a granddaughter, Amanda Durr and a grandson Taylor Walker (Stephanie).

Betty graduated from Mercer University where she was a member of the Alpha Delta Pi Sorority and the National Chemistry Society; she taught school in Macon before moving to Tallahassee in 1961. She was a homemaker, Girl Scout Leader, Member of the Tallahassee Garden Club and later worked at the Florida Department of Law Enforcement Crime Lab as an Evidence Supervisor.

She was an active and committed member of St. Paul's Methodist Church, serving on numerous committees and her beloved Burleigh Law Sunday School Class. For close to 60 years, she orchestrated monthly class parties

with a cadre of dear friends. She and Ralph also planned annual international travel tours with groups of 30 or more of their friends. Many of these friends have repeatedly said that they would have never seen the world had it not been for these trips. For years, she and Ralph enjoyed traveling with friends in their motor home to FSU football games and across the U.S.
