



Beverley (Bev) Steverding

August 19, 1926 - June 27, 2017

Beverley (Bev) Jean Steverding, age 90, passed peacefully on Tuesday, June 27, 2017 while in assisted care. Born August 19, 1926 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin to Chester and Bernice (Bunny) Kuhns with her twin sister, Patricia (Patt) Jones, who preceded Bev in passing in early 2016.

Beverley and her sister grew up on the east side of Cleveland, Ohio and graduated from Shaker Heights High School. Bev attended Miami University in Ohio before marrying Clarence Russell (Steve) Steverding, also of Cleveland. Together they sacrificed and worked hard raising their two daughters, Candice (Candy) Woodward and Patricia (Patti) Steverding-Kocsis and son, Thomas Russell Steverding.

Bev loved socializing, playing bridge and was involved in a number of community fundraisers. She had a love/hate relationship with gardening, often saying she spent more time picking weeds than planting flowers. She thoroughly enjoyed volunteering as a 'Pink Lady' at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital, well into her later years and was disheartened when she was no longer physically able to do so.

Beverley is survived by her children as well as six grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

We believe she was greeted into eternal life by her twin sister, Patt Jones, and her husband, Steve, who preceded her in passing in 2001.
