Bobby Cox, beloved husband, father, grandfather, and friend, passed away on January 13, 2025, at the age of 76. He was born in Hartford, Alabama, on August 20, 1948. Bobby was a graduate of Leon High School in Tallahassee, FL. Upon completion of high school, he began his career with Southeastern Telephone Company, which later became Sprint, dedicating 32 years of service before retiring in 2001.

In high school, Bobby was a passionate baseball player, a talent he continued to nurture as he played in a league for the telephone company, where he excelled as a pitcher. His love for sports and the outdoors remained a constant throughout his life. His love for family extended to the baseball field, where he was a proud supporter of his grandson, Cale, who followed in his footsteps and played the sport Bobby so dearly loved.
