



Carl Edward Lipscomb

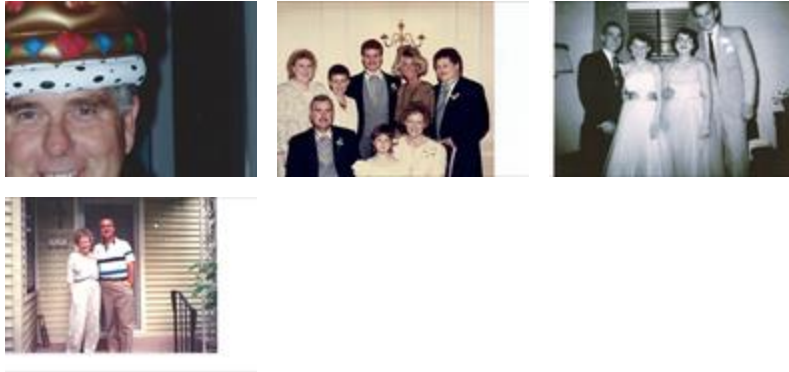
January 30, 1938 - April 4, 2015
