Carl Warren Tomberlin, Jr., age 46, of Quincy, passed away suddenly on Monday, January 14, 2019, at Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare, due to complications from cancer.

Carl was born in Yuma, Arizona to Patricia Randall and Carl Warren Tomberlin, Sr. His father served in the United States Military, so Carl lived many places while growing up. He attended the University of Central Florida and then transferred to Florida State University, where he was a cheerleader and earned a bachelors degree in Criminology. Carl had a thriving career in sales, having worked at Champs Sports, Garnet and Gold and currently at AlSCO. He was an avid chess player and especially enjoyed attending his children's performances and competitions.

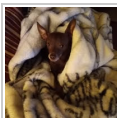

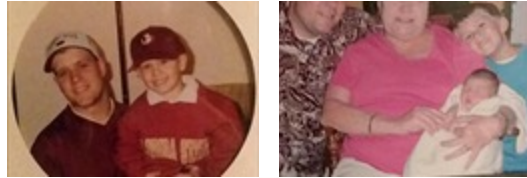

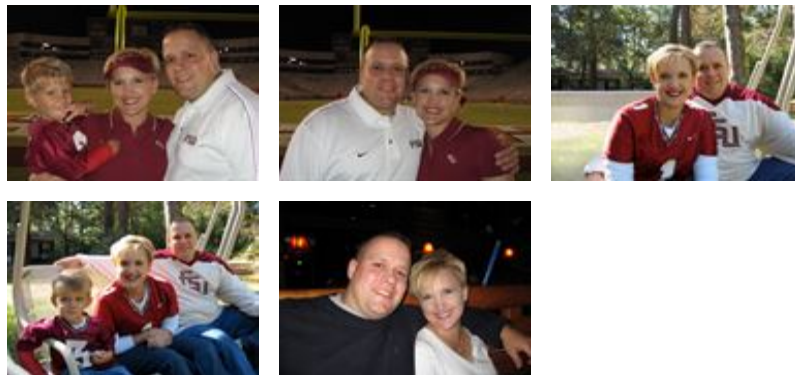
