Carol Ann Guemple, age 69, passed away on August 3, 2107, at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital surrounded by family. Carol was born in Baltimore, Maryland on October 23, 1947 to John Howard and Irene Taylor Guemple. She graduated from Bishop Moore High School in Orlando, Florida in 1965 and Mercy Hospital School of Nursing in Baltimore, Maryland in 1968.

Carol was a long time resident of Maitland, Florida where the Guemple family was one of the founding members of St. Mary Magdalen Catholic Church. She spent her career in nursing as a Critical Care Nurse at Florida Hospital. She also worked in the prison system in Seminole County where she published an article in the Journal of Prison and Jail Health, entitled "The County Jail – Has it Become a Mental Institution". Carol relocated to Tallahassee, Florida in 2007 and worked as a Case Manager for Tallahassee Memorial Hospital. She often commented that it gave her great satisfaction to help families in their time of need.

Carol is survived by her brother John Guemple, (Gail) – and their children John Guemple of Orlando, Florida; James Guemple (Christy) of Phoenix, Arizona; Katie Guemple of Satellite Beach, Florida and Jake Guemple of Denver, Colorado.
