Charles Wesley "Charlie" Prescott, 81, passed away January 29, 2016, at Select Specialty Hospital, Tallahassee, FL. Charlie was born in Port Arthur, TX. He graduated from the University of Texas, at Austin, TX, and attended graduate school at FSU. While at FSU, he was a member of the 1st Baptist Church college chorale, which was under the direction of Frank Boggs. He served in the U.S. Air Force and was stationed in San Antonio, TX. From boyhood, he loved studying and observing the weather, which led to a career as a meteorologist with the National Weather Service. After retiring from the NWS while living in Vicksburg, MS, he and his family moved back to Tallahassee. Charlie was a quiet, easy-going man who loved his family and friends, and enjoyed traveling, fishing, and watching his favorite football team, the FSU Seminoles. He is survived by his wife of 48 years, Martha Livingston Prescott of Tallahassee, and their daughter, Rebecca Danielle Prescott of Kailua, Hawaii. He was preceded in death by his parents, Julian and Edith Prescott of Port Arthur, TX, sister Bobbie Rhoe Adcock and brother-in-law Ben Adcock, both of Nederland, TX. Other survivors include a niece, Lisa Johnson (Dave) of Slidell, LA and nephew, John Alan Adcock (Cindy) of Nederland, TX. The family will receive friends Saturday, February 13, 1-2 p.m., in the Welcome Center at First Baptist Church of Tallahassee, with a memorial service to follow at 2 p.m. in the church sanctuary.
