



Charles Crawford

July 11, 1917 - October 24, 2011

Charles Crawford passed away October 24, 2011 at the age of 94. He was born on July 11, 1917 in Ironton, Ohio.

Charles attended Marshall University in West Virginia. Beginning in 1946, Charles entered the Chamber of Commerce field and became the Secretary of the Maryville, Tennessee Chamber of Commerce, which began a very successful career for him in Chamber of Commerce management from Bristol, VA/TN to Trenton, New Jersey and Charlotte, North Carolina. In 1980 he was elected President of Travel Unlimited in Charlotte, North Carolina and later retired to Tallahassee in 1987.

Charles will be remembered most for his charming smile and manners, his strong work ethic, "Crawford's Creed: Nothing happens unless you make it happen", his innovative ideas, always being well dressed and his love of music and dancing.

Charles was preceded in death by his first wife of more than 50 years, Anne Louise Hock Crawford. They were previously members of the War & Construction Krewe of Springtime Tallahassee. He is survived by his second wife, Lynette Davis of Thomasville, Georgia and his son Roger S. Crawford (Patty Bahmann) of Tallahassee.

He was of the Episcopalian faith, and served as usher for St. John's Episcopal Church for many years.

A service to celebrate his life will be held at 3:00 p.m., Thursday, October 27, 2011 at the St. John's Episcopal Church. The family will receive friends
