



## Charles Alton Golden

January 27, 1935 - August 29, 2024

Rev. Charles "Alton" Golden finished his race August 29, 2024, at the age of 89 at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital in Tallahassee, Florida.

In June of 1955, he wed his sweetheart Audrey Corley. Later they welcomed four beautiful girls, Ann, Beth, Cindy and Trish into their lives. He was the owner operator of Alton Golden Construction, building and repairing countless homes from Tallahassee to St. George Island. He also assisted in remodeling churches in Freeport, Florida and Louisiana, as well as helped build a Church in a Day in Whiteland, Indiana.

Though he was skilled at building earthly homes, his passion was preparing people for their heavenly home. He was an ordained minister with the United Pentecostal Church International and a faithful member ministering at the Pentecostals of the Capital City (Formerly Apostolic Church of Tallahassee). He was known for his love of the Word of God and teaching home Bible studies. Not only did he go to families' homes or invite them into his, but he also spent 12 years teaching inmates at Wakulla Correctional Institute. It is recorded that Alton baptized over 130 inmates in the wonderful name of Jesus and prayed 55 through to the Holy Ghost. He also had a desire to teach and mentor the next generation. Several young ministers have benefited from his guidance and Godly wisdom.

Next to his passion for God and souls, was his love for his family. You rarely saw him without his wife, Audrey. They truly did life together. You could not talk to him long before he would be telling you about one of his daughters, son-in-laws, grandchildren or great-grandchildren. They were the light of his life. His love extended beyond just blood family as many claim him and Mrs. Audrey as "Grandpa and Grandma Golden."

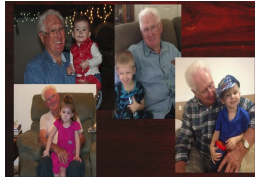
