Charles Dudley Hall, 74, of Quincy, passed away early Wednesday, August 29, 2012 in Tallahassee following a lengthy illness. He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Sue Hall. The service is scheduled for 2:00 PM, EDT, Thursday (today), August 30, 2012 at Forest Hills United Methodist Church in Quincy, with interment following in Hillcrest Cemetery. The family will receive friends from 10:00 AM until 12 noon, Thursday (today) at Bevis Funeral Home in Tallahassee.
