



Charles Richard "Chuck" Allen

Charles Richard Allen, 52, of Thomasville GA, passed away on January 31st, 2022, unexpectedly of natural causes.

Chuck was born on October 25th, 1969, to Charles Guyton Allen and Betty Allen (Nelson) in Macon, GA. After graduating from Dublin High in 1988, he attended Armstrong State College in Savannah. Chuck worked in the timber industry, and became an entrepreneur, eventually founding his own company, Timberland Southern. It suited him well since he liked spending time outdoors and traveled extensively throughout the state of Georgia that he loved.
