Christopher Anthony Breeze, 35, loving father, builder, handyman, and friend to all, died on November 17, 2012. Chris was born in Rockledge, Florida, and had lived in the Big Bend area since 1984. Chris is survived by his partner, Michele Walker; daughters Sancia and Isabell; Artemis Dove, mother of Chris's daughters; best friend, John Desrosiers; close family friend, Terra Reed; parents Jay and Carol; and grandparents Norman and Mary. Chris was happiest when working outdoors on building projects. In his free time, he enjoyed kayaking local rivers and springs, sharing a love of nature with his family and many friends.
