Clyde Ellis Asbury, Jr. MD, age 93, passed away on Sunday, March 9, 2014, at his home in Tallahassee, FL.

Born August 10, 1920 in Moberly, MO, Clyde attended the University of Missouri and graduated from Northwestern Medical School in International Medicine. While in Chicago, he met the love of his life, Julie Banks Asbury (deceased). They married and had an amazing life together for 61 years. After medical school, Clyde served in the US Army and in 1954 opened his medical practice in Lakeland, FL until he retired in 1985.

After retirement, Clyde and Julie moved to Crystal River, FL., where they lived happily as active members of the community for 24 years until they moved to Tallahassee, FL to be near their son. Clyde & Julie had two children: Clyde E. Asbury III (deceased) and Thomas B. Asbury.

Clyde is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Tom and Robyn Asbury; his grandson Thomas Asbury Jr.; his granddaughter Marsha Asbury Turner and her husband Chris Turner and a great granddaughter Logan Juliana Turner.
