Collean Glynn Hickox Stokes, 92 years young, was born February 12, 1933, in Jacksonville, Florida and entered her eternal heavenly home on May 11, 2025, Mother's Day, surrounded by her children and family.

She was a devoted Christian whose life radiated her unwavering faith in our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. She was a charter member of the Arlington Road Baptist Church in Jacksonville, Florida, raised her children in the First Baptist Church, Baldwin, Florida and attended Immanuel Baptist Church in Tallahassee, Florida for over 45 years. She loved to sing and was a member of the choir in every church she was with. Her angelic voice was sought after for numerous weddings and funerals. She was a faithful servant who taught Sunday School and was always reaching out and visiting those who were not able to attend a service.

She graduated from Landon High School in Jacksonville, Florida and was part of the Lionette Drill Team.

She was part-owner and managed the legendary Stokes Drive-In restaurant in Baldwin Florida for many years. This was "THE" hangout in Baldwin during the late sixties and early seventies.

She loved her Faith Radio Station (WFRF) in Tallahassee. She volunteered on membership mailing days and traveled with them to Kenya and Uganda Africa to witness locally and all of them loved to call her Mama. She also traveled

twice with Immanuel Baptist on mission trips to Guatemala.

She also spent many days at Early's Kitchen where her culinary skills were tested. We were always told Mr. Eddy used many of her recipes for the breakfast and lunch menu.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Herman O. Stokes Jr, her mother Lois Highsmith Smith, her father William Mose Hickox, her eldest son Mark Alan Stokes and two brothers, Francis Smith Jr and James Jerry Smith. And her best friend of 80 years, Pearl Williams.
