Dan Blanchard Boddie, 70, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away peacefully on January 15, 2024, after a sudden illness. He was born in Shreveport, Louisiana on May 14, 1953, to the late Dan Blanchard and Ann Honovich Boddie. He attended Northwestern State University in Natchitoches, Louisiana, where he played football as a Linebacker for the NSU Demons. After graduating, he began his career in the freight industry with Roadway Express. Due to his excellent management skills, he was sent to problem solve at various terminals throughout Louisiana and California.

In 1988, he married the love of his life, Jacalyn Leigh King. They celebrated their 35th wedding anniversary this past October. They had many wonderful adventures as their jobs relocated them throughout Louisiana and California. When not working, Dan liked to attend various racetracks to watch and bet the horses. He also liked working in the yard and helping people by volunteering for various non-profits.

Upon retirement, their adventures continued into Texas and Florida and Dan was able to actively participate in his long-time passion of horse racing. Dan liked winning races, but his priority was always the well-being of his horses.
