Daniel (Danny) William Stafford Swaby, age 16, of Tallahassee, Florida passed away unexpectedly on April 15, 2017 in Tallahassee Florida. Visitation will be held at Epiphany Lutheran Church, 8300 Deerlake Road West, Tallahassee, Florida, on April 22, 2017 beginning at 9:30 AM.
