Debora had a heart for the Chinese students who were attending FSU. She was concerned about where they would spend eternity. She had them over every Sunday evening for a Bible study and food. Many of them also became a part of her family.

She was an avid runner who ran many half marathons, 5-k's and 10-k's. She completed the Disney Marathon for her 50th birthday along side her sister, Anita Livingston Rudzinski.

She also had a heart for missions and has been to Peru, Nicaragua and China to share the love of Jesus.

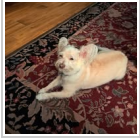
