Deborah (Debbie) Lynn Rafferty Giudice, daughter of Mary T. and George A. Rafferty, Sr. a phenomenal wife, mother, grandmother, daughter, sister and cherished friend died at Moffitt Cancer Center, Tampa, Florida on April 11, 2024, surrounded by her family after a courageous battle with cancer.

She graduated from Gainesville High School and attended Auburn University before completing her studies and graduating from the University of Florida. She was the consummate mother, caregiver and homemaker focused on raising her children and spreading her unique sparkle with all who were lucky enough to cross her path. One of her favorite phrases was happiness is a choice, choose wisely.

The creative side of Debbie began to shine when she discovered a knack for finding discarded treasures, researching their value and selling them, transforming a hobby into a successful business. Debbie was fiercely loyal to her family and friends and the warmth of her love was felt in the many messages, calls and unexpected gifts that might surprise and brighten your day. She always saw the best in others, no matter the circumstance. Her kindness and caring inspired others to have a positive outlook.

She is survived by her high school sweetheart and husband of nearly 42 years William A. Giudice, daughter and two sons Brittany (Joe) Knippel, Michael (Kristin) Giudice and Drew (Kara) Giudice. The loves of her life were her seven grandchildren Emma, Jack and Lila Knippel, Anna Lynn, Alice and Will Giudice and Palmer Giudice. 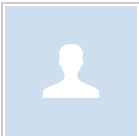
