Delores Watts Wussler passed away on February 20, 2015. Delores was born to William R. Watts and Amanda Emanuelson Watts in Primghar, IA on March 4, 1932, and was raised in Paulina, Iowa. She lost her sight in 1991 and devoted much of the remainder of her life to helping others adjust to blindness. Delores was preceded in death by her son, David Wussler. She is survived by her husband, Lewis Wussler; siblings, Rodger Watts, Russell Watts & Ruth Pasquale; a son Doug Wussler (Cindy Green), daughter Sharyn Wussler Davidson (Glen) and son Danny Wussler (Joni); and five grandchildren, Austin, Tanner, Benson and Kathryn Davidson, and Gage West.
