Juanita Dolores Lucita Rivera Sichrovsky (or Mrs. Dolores Lucy Sichrovsky, as she preferred) went to join her husband in the eternities on January 12, 2015. Dolores was born December 10, 1933 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. After spending the majority of her childhood in a convent and subsequent foster care, she married her husband Frank Sichrovsky in March 1952 in Chicago, Illinois.

She spent the first few years of their marriage as an army bride during which time her older daughter was born. After her husband left the army they settled outside of Chicago, Illinois where her son was born, followed fourteen years later by her younger daughter. In 1972 Dolores's family moved to Phoenix, Arizona where she worked with her husband to run a successful air-conditioning business. It was in Phoenix that she joined the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints which she loved and loved to share with others. After the death of her husband of 62 years in 2013 she moved to Tallahassee, Florida where she made friends and shared the joys of her life with those she met there.

Dolores was predeceased by her husband Frank Milton Sichrovsky, her son Frank Michael Sichrovsky, and her brother Edward Rivera.
