



## Dr. Robert Mason Snider

Dr. Robert Mason Snider, 88 of Tallahassee, passed away Saturday, December 28, 2024, at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was born on November 15, 1936, in Fisk, Missouri to his parents Joseph Ford and Martha Charlotte Snider. He graduated from the University of Missouri with a B.S. and then attended Medical School at the University of Missouri.

After completion of Medical School, he proudly served as a flight surgeon with the United States Air Force and went on to practice his specialty of Ear, Nose and Throat medicine for over fifty years in Tallahassee. He was a former president of the Exchange Club and the Children's Home Society and was a member of St. Peter's Anglican Cathedral.

Bob was a kind and generous man with a huge heart and a great love of life, God, family and friends. He enjoyed many hobbies, his favorite being bird hunting, but he also enjoyed fishing and planting his vegetable garden every year and, of course, spending time with his family and friends. He was a prodigious reader who constantly loved learning about his passion, medicine, in addition to whatever other subjects that captured his interest.

Dr. Bob loved his work and knew at the age of nine that he wanted to be a doctor. He said there was never a day in his many years of practice that he didn't wake up looking forward to going into work.
