



## Eleanore A. Campbell

August 5, 1925 - August 19, 2017

A Tallahassee Silver Star has left us to shine in the heavens. Eleanore Campbell passed away August 19, 2017, at the age of 92. She was born in Oakmont, PA in 1925. After she graduated from Verona High School, she gave up competitive swimming to become a Public Health Service Nurse Cadet at Presbyterian Hospital in Pittsburgh, PA, graduating in 1946 as an RN.

She married Boyd Campbell in the parlor of her parent's home in 1946. The family moved to Saint Petersburg in 1952, where she worked at Mound Park Hospital (Bayfont). The family then moved to Tallahassee in 1965, and Eleanore began working at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital. Her last twelve years there she was O.R. Supervisor. After retiring from TMH in 1985, she volunteered with TMH Auxiliary for over 20 yrs. and with Big Bend Hospice for 20 yrs.

Eleanore was a member of the TMH Retirees, Killlearn Ladies Golf Association and the Presbyterian University Hospital Nurses Alumnae Assoc. She was a member of Fellowship Presbyterian Church in Tallahassee, FL. She was preceded in death by her parents, Charles & Goldmae and her one true love, husband Boyd.

Survivors include two daughters, Roberta Bobbie Carpenter and Mary Campbell Yeomans and her husband John; and, adopted son, Glenn Hornecker and his wife Laura.
