



Elon Virginia Livingston McIntyre

June 24, 1917 - December 21, 2010

Elon Virginia Livingston McIntyre, 93, died December 21, 2010 after a long illness with Alzheimer's.

She was born on a farm in Malone, Florida on June 24, 1917. One of 8 children, she had four brothers and three sisters. She graduated from Malone High School in 1936. In order to get to school, she and her siblings rode there on a buggy each day. The family attended Friendship Baptist Church and most of her brothers and sisters are buried there. She attended Southside Baptist Church in Dothan, AL and was a member of Forest Heights Baptist Church in Tallahassee.

On February 24, 1936, she married Paul McIntyre and they had two children, Janis Marie McIntyre Jones and Robert Charles McIntyre.

Some of the activities she enjoyed were teaching Sunday School, sewing, making clothes, crocheting, and growing plants and flowers. She was a member of a garden club and gave many programs. She was an excellent cook, famous for her cakes.

She leaves her daughter, Janis McIntyre Jones (husband Dael); son, Robert Charles McIntyre (wife Barbara); three grandchildren, Sharon K. Jones; Robert C. McIntyre, Jr.; and Andrew McIntyre; three great-grandchildren, Sierra; Megan; and Alasdair McIntyre; as well as many nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Paul McIntyre; four brothers, Duncan; Lionel; Joe; and Buford; and three sisters, Mattye; Mary; and Janie. The funeral service will be held at 11:00am EST on Monday, December 27,
