Ernest Paul Moore, 79, of Tallahassee, FL passed away on June 14, 2022. Paul was born in Louisville, KY on July 26, 1942, to Ernest and Anna Moore. He grew up in Tallahassee, graduated from Florida High School and attended Chipola Junior College in Marianna, FL.

Paul was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather who loved his family dearly. A man of strong faith, he was a member of Christ Church Tallahassee who touched and made a real difference in so many lives. A role model to many, Paul was a loving, caring man with a huge heart and a great sense of humor.
