Ethel W. Eubanks, 97, departed to be with her Lord and Savior surrounded by family members at Community Hospice, St. Vincent's Hospital, Jacksonville, Florida on December 6, 2015. She was born September 14, 1918 to Henry Houston and Anna Louise Williams in River Junction, Florida.

Ethel resided in Tallahassee, Florida and was a long time member of Maranatha Baptist Church (currently Grace Point) where she taught Sunday school for 46 years to 2 and 3 year olds. During her service in this capacity, Ethel taught several generations of member families. She was also part of the church choir and enjoyed singing and participating in musical programs. 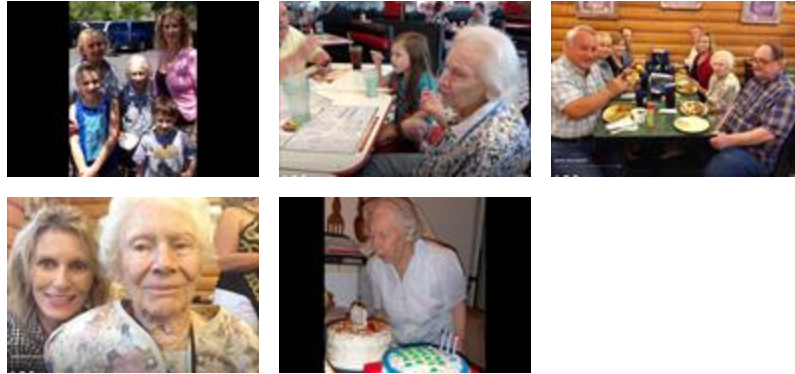
