



## Frieda Eleanor Heil Hutchison

September 28, 1923 - July 1, 2024

Frieda was born Frieda Elenore Heil in Columbus Ohio in 1923. She graduated from East High School in 1941. After High School she held several clerical jobs, and when war broke out, she registered to join the Navy and go through nursing school. When she brought the papers home for her dad to sign, she was moved by his sad reaction. He had hoped having four daughters that none of them would ever have to go to war and experience what he had seen in France and Belgium during WWI. That so moved her that she never turned in the papers. During this time, she met and married Roger A. Moore, a Lieutenant in the Army Air Corps stationed at Lockbourne Air Base in Columbus. They raised two children, Roger Jr. and Christie Anne. The family attended Christ Lutheran Church. Frieda graduated from Franklin University with a BA in Business Administration in 1979. Frieda worked for the State of Ohio Rehabilitation Division during the 1980's, handling food distribution for the state.

In later life she remarried, to Jack H. Hutchison and moved to Tallahassee, Florida. After working as a realtor for a while she worked for the State of Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services WIC program, retiring in 1995. During her time in Tallahassee, she was a member of Grace Lutheran Church and spent 25 years as a volunteer for the Capital Regional hospital, retiring in 2020. With two of her sisters and daughter Frieda knitted many infant hats and afghans for the Tallahassee Sister City program and

other organizations.

She was preceded in death by both husbands, her parents, William and Rose Heil; sisters Ernestine Heil, Clara Anderson, Lucille Miller, and Wilma Turton, and daughter Christie Moore. She is survived by son Roger Moore, Jr. and daughter-in-law Gail, granddaughters Tabitha and Roxie Moore, great-grandsons Raven and John Moore, and numerous cousins and their children and grandchildren.

A memorial service will take place on July 20, 2024, at 2pm, at Grace Lutheran Church, Tallahassee, FL. Interment of ashes will take place later in Columbus Ohio.
