Fenton Garnett Avant, child of God, died May 10, 2016. She was born August 11, 1960 in Tallahassee, Florida to parents George Davis Avant and Gayle Elizabeth Christensen Avant. She was named for her grandmother Fenton Garnett Davis Avant and was the first granddaughter for maternal grandparents Carl Andrew and Elizabeth Turner Christensen and paternal grandparents David Alonzo and Fenton Garnett Davis Avant. She was raised in the Christian faith, baptized at First Presbyterian Church, made her confession of faith at Faith Presbyterian Church. She was a dear sweet person who loved her family and friends. Garnett graduated from Godby High School and was active in the Civinettes, Thespians Drama Club and Chorus. She was the first fifth generation graduate of FSU in her family with a double Major in Art History and Spanish with a minor in Italian. She was in the Glee Club Chorus and Gamma Phi Beta Sorority and enjoyed studying at the FSU program in Florence, Italy and in Costa Rica. Her degree in Art History helped her in her work at the Special Collections department at the Strozier Library. The family has many works of art she created. She graduated from Keiser College with a Degree in Computer Graphics and Design. Garnett was an excellent horsewoman riding in shows and receiving ribbons.
