



## Florence Carr Huskey Trentham

October 25, 1926 - May 3, 2012

Florence Carr Huskey Trentham of Alligator Point, Florida passed away at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital on May 3 after a long illness; she had been a resident of Eden Springs Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Medart for nearly a year. She was the youngest daughter of Mattie and Elbert Carr, born October 25, 1926 in Seymour, Tennessee where she lived most of her life before moving to Alligator Point, FL in 1992.
