



Francine Cannella "Fran" Hudson

November 3, 1945 - May 24, 2012

Francine Cannella "Fran" Hudson, 66, of Tallahassee and formerly of Tampa, passed away Thursday, May 24, 2012 in Tallahassee, following a lengthy illness.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 4:00 PM, EDT, Tuesday, May 29, 2012 at Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church in Tallahassee. Burial will follow at Roselawn Cemetery, also in Tallahassee. A prayer vigil for family and friends will be held from 7:00 PM until 9:00 PM, Monday, May 28th at Blessed Sacrament.

In lieu of flowers, gifts in memory may be made to the Fran Hudson Memorial Scholarship Fund, which will be established in her name at Trinity Catholic School, 706 East Brevard Street, Tallahassee, FL 32308.

A native of Tampa, Fran graduated from the Academy of the Holy Name in Tampa, and moved to Tallahassee in 1963 to attend Florida State University, where she received a bachelor's degree in Elementary Education in 1966. She taught at Trinity Catholic from 1967 until 1971, and returned to teach again in 1981 and later became Assistant Principal, the position she held at her passing.

Her community involvement included the activities of Delta Kappa Gamma, the education sorority at Florida State, as well as being part of the "Super Woman" social group in Tallahassee. She and her family were also longtime residents of Dog Island.

Fran was formerly a longtime communicant of the Co-Cathedral of St. Thomas

More and later became very active in the Church life at Blessed Sacrament; where she served as a Eucharistic Adorer and Eucharistic Minister.

Survivors include the same wonderful man she married 45 years ago, Eddie Hudson, also of Tallahassee; the two joys of her life, her children Christopher D. Hudson (Aidan) and Deanna H. Edwards (Scott), of Tallahassee; two brothers, Norman S. Cannella of Tampa and Theodore Cannella of Cabbage Key; and four grandchildren, Cullen B. Edwards, Macy M. Edwards, Tyler J. Morales and Gabriella M Morales, all of Tallahassee.

Fran was preceded in death by her parents, Norman O. and Angie S. Cannella.
