



Francis Joseph Panzarino Sr.

September 30, 1944 - September 3, 2023

Francis Joseph Panzarino passed away, aged 78, on September 3rd, 2023. He is survived by his four children, Frank Jr. (Brandi), Anissa (Brie), Chris (Cyndi), and Michael (MacKenzie). In addition to his children, he is survived by his grandchildren— Kaitlyn, Cheyenne, Cody, Michael, Jarrett, Tyler, Tres, and great-grandchild Iyla Mae.

Frank was a graduate of Suffern High School and went on to attend Villanova, Rockland Community College, and Georgia State University. After earning his degree, he had a long successful and varied career including Director of Housing Development, Executive Director of Housing authority for both Binghamton and Allen County (Ohio), Behavioral Counselor, Contract Manager, Business Owner, and Consultant. Frank was also a veteran of the United States Air Force from serving during the Vietnam War.

On June 18th, 1966, Frank and Ann were married and started their life together. Over the course of their journey through life, they lived in many cities and states including New York, Ohio, Georgia, and finally rooting in Florida. Frank was a man of many talents. There was hardly a task, problem, or obstacle in which he did not have advice or counsel. From him, his children learned valuable skills that would carry them successfully in life and into their own families. Frank appreciated the simple pleasures in life including nature, animals (personified in his canine companion Casey), sunsets (especially at Shell Point), boating, sailing, sports (both coaching and spectating), and, most importantly to him—family. His love of music was also a large part of the

values and lessons imparted upon his children. Many times, throughout his journey, he occupied the musical director position for his parish and shared his love and talent with all who listened.

Like his wife, Frank was also a strong advocate for the importance of family, communication, and forgiveness. With his welcoming demeanor, Frank was never shy to say hello or greet someone new. He and Ann created and maintained a welcoming home for those who entered, a channel of safety and refuge for those in need, and a force for good that is needed in the world today.
