F.D. "Dick" Folsom, 100, died Tuesday, January 18, 2011 in Tallahassee. He was a native of Jackson County, FL. and moved to Tallahassee in 1934. He was retired from Daffin Mercantile Company after more than 40 years of service. He then worked for Marpan Supply in Tallahassee. He was a member of Tallahassee First Baptist Church since 1934, he was a Deacon and a Sunday school teacher.
