



## Fred Phillips Stanley

April 26, 1944 - March 5, 2017

Fred Phillips Stanley, A.K.A. KIDDO, age 72, of Quincy, FL died Sunday March 5, 2017 at his daughter home in Tallahassee, FL. Kiddo lost his two year battle with cancer, but only the last couple of months interfered with his favorite hobby, Bowling. Fred was an avid bowler of over 50 years and during this period of time he bowled four perfect games of 300. In 2002, Fred was inducted into the Tallahassee Bowling Association Hall of Fame. He also was instrumental in organizing and starting the Junior Bowling League in Tallahassee. He coached and assisted with Ladies Softball Teams that traveled and played in the Tallahassee League. Fred was also a fan of NASCAR Racing and in his early years was involved in Drag Racing. He loved to cheer and watch the FSU Seminoles play and was a big fan.

Fred worked and retired from the State of Florida Department of Revenue and the State of Georgia Department of Revenue as an Investigator.

Fred is preceded death by his Sister, Adelaide Raa, his Mother, Helen A. Stanley, his Father, James Randall Stanley, and his Grandmother, Adelaide Phillips Pettijohn.
