Geneva D. Bryan, 88, passed away Friday, January 27, 2017 in Tallahassee, FL. She was born February 21, 1928 to Harris and Estelle Davis. She was a native of Tallahassee and lived here most of her life.

She graduated in 1946 from Leon High school and was in the marching Red Coats Band. Geneva retired in 1977 after working for more than 30 years in the Florida Secretary of State office.
