George Henry Unglaub, age 84 passed away Tuesday, April 16, 2019. He was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin to Evelyn and George Frank Unglaub. He was a 1952 graduate of Cudahy High School and served in the U.S. Marine Corps. He Married Beatrice Momsen and had four children. He opened a gas station in St. Petersburg, FL in 1960. In 1969 he moved to Tallahassee and opened his first gas station on Monroe and Tennessee St. Eventually, George owned 7 gas stations and one auto parts store all in Tallahassee. In 1989 George married Vanessa Makemson. She had a son and together they had a daughter.

Since 1990, George based his life on Ephesians 2: 2-10. "And we were dead in our trespasses and sins in which we once walked following the course of this world...But God, Being rich in mercy. 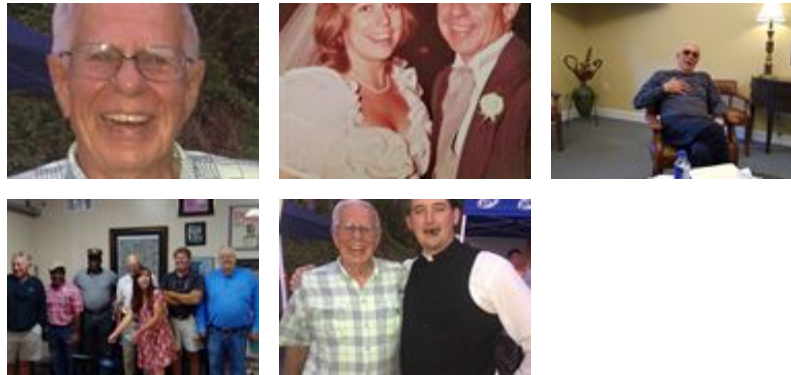
