The circle of life is complete, Gerald Lee Holdren (Jerry), 88 of Crawfordville, Florida passed away in the comfort and love of his family on Saturday, October 16, 2021. Born in Botetourt County, Virginia , Gerald was the son of the late, Howard Lee Holdren and Gladys St. Clair. A member of Evergreen Baptist Church, Jerry was a passionate advocate for family and friends. As a proud member of the community, Gerald received a Certificate of Achievement from the Wakulla County Sheriff's Office for completion of the 21st Citizen's Academy in 2006. An avid hunter and outdoorsman, Jerry will be most remembered for his unique ability and fondness of storytelling. From 1952 to 1960, Gerald Lee Holdren served his country in the U.S. Navy. He was awarded three medals, the Navy Good Conduct Medal, the Navy Occupation Service Medal and the National Defense Service Medal. As a QM-3, Gerald travelled to 26 countries aboard the U.S.S. Zellers, often immortalized in his community as "The Navy Man."

Gerald is survived by his wife and love of his life, Joan Wright Holdren, of 68 years. His continued legacy is carried on by his three daughters, Vicky, Dale and Katie; 7 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren.
